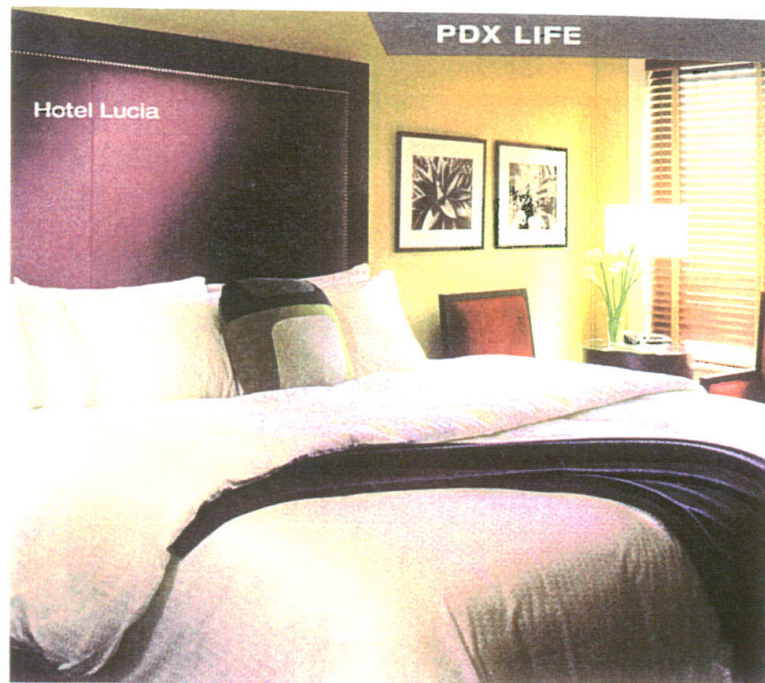


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Last but not least on our list of P-town hot spots to lay your head are sister hotels **Hotel Lucia** (400 SW Broadway, 225-1717, [hotellucia.com](http://hotellucia.com)) and **Hotel deLuxe** (729 SW 15th Avenue, 219-2094, [hoteldeluxeportland.com](http://hoteldeluxeportland.com)). Both locations are high on service, offering a 24-hour concierge, a menu of pillow choices, iPod docking stations in every room and even iPod's loaded with your favorite genre of music if you forgot to bring your own.

Rooms at the Lucia range from \$169-\$259, offering cool, clean lines, a modern décor and all the amenities you could possibly think of while maintaining a distinct sense of tranquility—perfect for the weary business traveler. Grand and luxurious suites (up to \$729) attract rock stars touring in town, and the likes of Sting and Cher have been seen on the premises.

The contemporary style of Hotel Lucia is complemented throughout with the work of Pulitzer-prize-winning Photographer David Hume Kennerly, most of which focus on either politicians or—you guessed it—*Seinfeld* characters. Never before have the likes of Jimmy Carter and Kramer spent so much quality time together.

Finally, a stay at Hotel deLuxe is like taking a trip back in time to Hollywood's Golden Era, with antique chandeliers and gilded gold accents adorning the ceiling and black and white photos of 30's-50's movies on every floor.

No two rooms (\$159 to \$279) are alike, but all are rich in detail, comfort and grace, with warm, inviting colors and era-appropriate accents. But if you really want to relax in true 40's Hollywood Glam style, book the Marlene Dietrich Suite (\$329), with a parlor area perfect for martini drinking and—get this—an eight-foot circular bed. Hugh Hefner would be proud.
